Westchester, IL (September 13, 2018) – Access to Care is hosting a community health and resource fair on Saturday, September 29 at St. Pius X Catholic Church in Stickney from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. The event is open to the public and features a great line-up of vendors for residents to visit. A few highlights of the fair include Walgreens providing free flu vaccines (while supplies last) to uninsured, attendees with insurance can get their flu shots and Walgreens will bill the insurance. The Cook County Clerk will be registering voters and have a voting booth on site to practice. A local fitness trainer will be doing a healthy cooking demonstration as well as a low-impact workout.
